

# Sacrifices of the Saints

## 1A. EXAMPLES OF SACRIFICES:

### 1b. **The sacrifice of praise** – continually

Heb. 13:15 “Let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually.”

### 2b. **The sacrifice of possessions** – liberally

Heb. 13:16 “But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.”

Phil. 4:18 “Having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.”  
The sacrifice includes *monetary* and *material* help.

### 3b. **The sacrifice of the person** – rationally

Rom. 12:1-2 “I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.”

1b. Praise to God: Phil. 3:10

2b. Provision for personal needs: Phil. 4:19-20

3b. Proof of salvation: Phil 4:17

## 3A. THE EXPECTATION OF SACRIFICES:

1b. Compensation: Phil. 4:17, 19 (“fruit that may abound to your account”)

2b. Blessings: 2. Cor. 9:7 (“God loveth a cheerful giver”)

3b. Benefits: Phil. 4:19
