Observation at Christmas time:

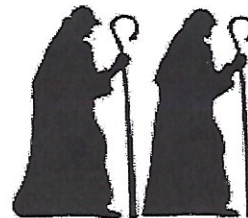
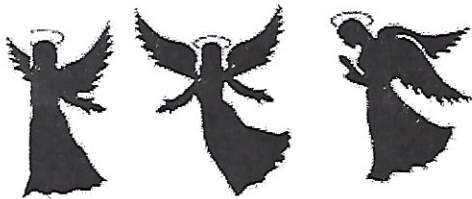
In a proper study of the scriptures, three steps are necessary:

3. Application—Asking **What does it mean to me?**



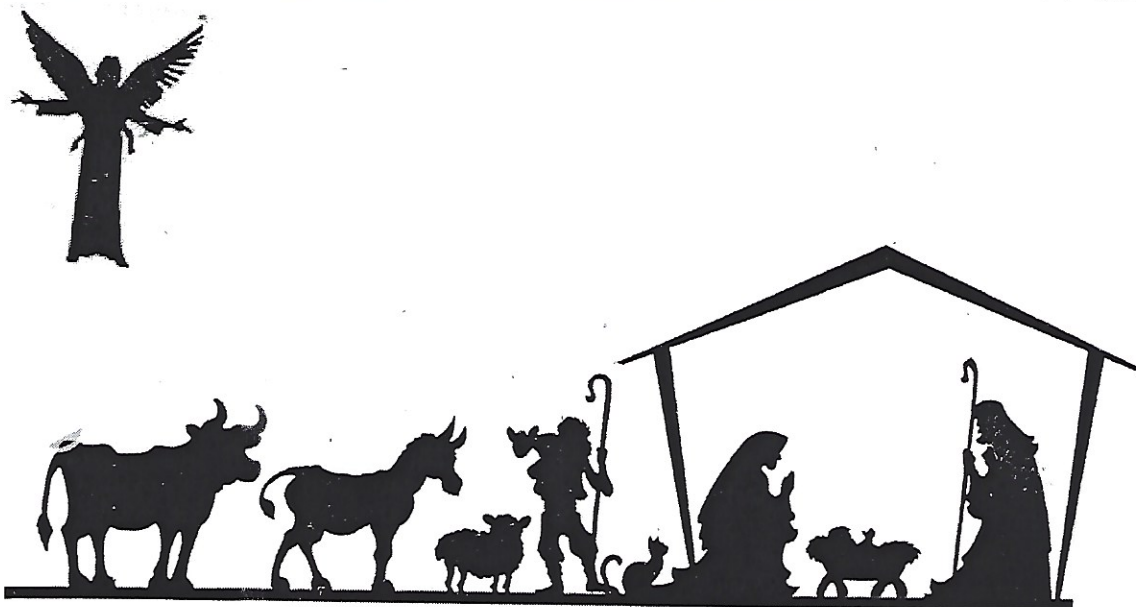
Frequently the Bible student skips the first two steps and majors on application.
